



## Safety Week - Year 5 Clyde and Mersey Class

For Safety Week in Clyde class the children have been learning about internet safety and what they can do to be safe online. The children have learnt many strategies they can do when they are feeling unsafe online, for example, tell an adult straight away if something is wrong, only add people they know, only play games that are age appropriate, do not data share, do not share personal details...the list goes on! The children have created posters on the safety they have learnt to inform others on what they can do to stay safe.





Last week in Mersey Class, we found out about dangers in different situations. In the kitchen we discovered there are lots of risks and so many dangers, including ovens, kettles, irons, steamers, grills, and knives. In the bedroom there might be straighteners, a high bed, bunk beds and hairdryers. In the garden there are dangers such as ponds, poisonous plants, holes in the ground, rakes and spades and pools. We drew our scenarios and presented them to the class.



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#### **School Uniform Reminder**

Please send your child in the correct uniform as outlined in the School Uniform Policy on our website. Children should wear grey trousers, skirt/pinafore or shorts **not leggings**.

Please remember that flat, sensible, safe, black shoes (no trainers) should be worn.



Hairclips and headbands should be plain and should not cause obstruction to anyone's learning, or cause distraction to any learner.

Children need to have their PE kit in school, as they will change in school for PE sessions. Please ensure that PE kit is as outlined in the uniform policy.

#### **Jewellery**

Children may not wear jewellery to school at any time (except for small studs, which **must be 5mm in diameter or smaller**, and watches) other than for religious or cultural reasons. Children in **Foundation** may **not** wear earrings in view of the physical aspects of their learning.
