#### **Renaissance Reading Program**



(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, PARKING, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that Plymouth City Council acting under section 16a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), have made an Order the effect of which is:

To prohibit the driving, parking, waiting, loading and unloading of vehicles in:

Compton Avenue - from the junction of Dormy Avenue to the junction with Culme Road. 05/06/22 noon until 4pm.

**Agaton Road** – from the lane between Agaton Road and Drina Lane to the entrance to Butterfly Lodge. 04/06/22 9am until10pm.

Clevedon Park Avenue - from outside number 11 & 12 to outside number 35 & 36. 05/06/22, noon until 9pm

The Grove - from outside number 14 to outside number 23. 05/06/2022 1pm till 6pm.

Rendle Street - From: Plymouth Foyer car park exit to Jays Scrap Yard Entrance. 05/06/2022 7am until 11pm

Glendower Road – from outside number 2 to outside number 52. 04/06/22 10am until 9pm.

Shirburn Road – from outside number 27 to outside number 61. 05/06/22 1pm until 10pm.

**Mowhay Road -** From the top of the single track bridge to The Bollards at the end of No.42 driveway, 04/06/2022. 10.30am until midnight.

**Hotham Place** – from the junction of Queens Gate to the junction with Molesworth Road 05/06/2022. 8am till 1130am **Salisbury Road** - from Cranbourne Avenue to Cecil Avenue. 03/06/2022 9am until 9pm.

**Manor Street and Manor Gardens -** From behind the Plot on Manor Gardens to Corner of Manor Gardens and around to Manor Street outside Union Corner. 05/06/2022. 9am until 5pm.

Palmerston Street - from outside number 1 to outside number 66. 04/06/2022. 10am until midnight

Knighton Road - From outside number 10 to outside number 27. 03/06/2022 10am until midnight.

Onslow Road Iane East, Elphinstone Road & Beauchamp Crescent - From the junction of Onslow Road to the junction with Forest Avenue. 03/06/2022 9am until 11.30pm.

Powisland Drive - from the junction of Roborough Avenue to the junction with Caradon Close, 04/06/2022. Noon until 4pm.

The prohibition of driving, parking, waiting loading and unloading will be in operation when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed and is necessary, in the interests of public safety, whilst the event of the Queen's Jubilee street party takes place.

The Order shall come into force on 02<sup>nd</sup> June 2022 and shall continue in force for a maximum of 12 weeks

It is anticipated that the road closure for the Queen's Jubilee street party will commence on the dates and times shown above.

#### School Uniform Reminder

Please send your child in the correct uniform as outlined in the School Uniform Policy on our website. Children should wear grey trousers, skirt/pinafore or shorts **not leggings**.

Please remember that flat, sensible, safe, black shoes (no trainers) should be worn.

Hairclips and headbands should be plain and should not cause obstruction to anyone's learning, or cause distraction to any learner.

Children need to have their PE kit in school, as they will change in school for PE sessions. Please ensure that PE kit is as outlined in the uniform policy.

#### **Jewellery**

Children may not wear jewellery to school at any time (except for small studs, which **must be 5mm in diameter or smaller**, and watches) other than for religious or cultural reasons. Children in **Foundation** may **not** wear earrings in view of the physical aspects of their learning.

"For health and safety reasons, all pupils are required to remove earrings during PE lessons."

As the weather is improving, please ensure that you send your child with suncream on, a sun hat and a full water bottle.

#### **Uniform Store Plymouth**

The Uniform Store Plymouth is a free service for families to kit out their children for school. Through donations of good quality school uniform, we give these items out to those in need, free of charge – no referral is needed. We operate a pop-up shop in Plymouth City Centre throughout the school summer holidays, and a 'Click & Collect' service that operates throughout the year, where parents/carers can order the uniform that they need for their children and collect it from our collection point.

#### **Updated Covid-19 Guidance**

Children and young people with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, who are otherwise well, can continue to attend their education setting. Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people, where they can. They can go back to school, college or childcare, and resume normal activities when they no longer have a high temperature and they are well enough to attend.

# Children and young people aged 18 years and under who have a positive test result

It is not recommended that children and young people are tested for COVID-19 unless directed to by a health professional.

If a child or young person has a positive COVID-19 test result they should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days after the day they took the test, if they can. After 3 days, if they feel well and do not have a high temperature, the risk of passing the infection on to others is much lower. This is because children and young people tend to be infectious to other people for less time than adults.

Children and young people who usually go to school, college or childcare and who live with someone who has a positive COVID-19 test result should continue to attend as normal.
