
Volcanoes

Volcanoes are mountains or hills that are typically conical and have a crater of which lava and hot gases have been erupted from the Earth's crust.

There are many volcanoes in the world and today I'm going to write about two of them. The first volcano is Mount Hood and it is situated in North America. It is 11,249 feet tall and is potentially an active stratovolcano but based on its history the volcano is unlikely to erupt and is informally considered dormant. It is the only mountain offers the opportunity to go skiing all year round in Oregon.

Our second volcano is much different to our other volcano it is Mount Tambora of which lies in Indonesia. One of the differences being is that this volcano has erupted and its last eruption was the largest in recorded in human history in 1815. The explosion was heard on Sumatra Island, more than 2,000 kilometres away.

When a volcano erupts, it means there is enough molten rock called magma and pressure on it to cause a volcanic eruption. The magma rises up through the central tube and emerges out through the top of the volcano.
