





#### **Covid Reminders**

No child should come to school if they, **or anyone they live with**, has symptoms of Covid-19. These are:

Please ensure that you contact the school **immediately** to inform us if your child or a member of your household becomes unwell and requires a Covid-19 PCR test at a test centre, or if you are advised to self-isolate or have outcome of tests. Please leave a message on the school answerphone if this is before or after school hours. Children who are required to isolate at home can continue to work using their eSchools account.

Please remember that if you use the 30 minute Lateral Flow Tests for you and your family and have a positive result—you must go on to get a PCR test at a test centre. If positive please make sure that you inform us at school promptly. Thank you for your continued support in this matter.

#### Reporting absences for children

Please contact the school <u>by 9:15am</u> to let us know if your child will be absent, <u>providing details</u> of the reason for the absence. This ongoing communication will enable us to ensure that we continue to keep children safe and follow all necessary government guidelines. We appreciate your continued assistance.

#### **Social Distancing Reminders**

- Please remember only <u>one</u> adult when dropping off or picking up your child, which helps to reduce the number of adults on the premises.

#### **School Uniform Reminder**
